
### Registration Free of Charge



## Redesign and reimagine of museum development concept:

# Change and evaluate of collections and museums of the Cultural Institution of Bonyad Museums (CIBM) during Covid- 19pandemic

### Abstract


The Outbreaking of the Covid-19 pandemic caused the closure of cultural institutions and museums not only in Iran but also all around the world. Along with all the problems that arose, it presented new opportunities and challenges in the concept of the development of museums. On the other hand, the lack of visitors in museums and exhibitions provided a great opportunity for the museums' experts of the Cultural Institution of Bonyad museums to improve their workspace, rectify the museums' spaces, information exchange, and cooperation with scientific and academic institutions. Moreover, one of the great achievements was the opportunity to redesign and modify the Dafineh Building into four museums: World Art Museum, Islamic Art Museum, Museum of Antique gems and jewelry, Money Museum. The Dafineh Building was a place of the Money Museum and collection of CIBM. This designed development led to exhibiting four thousand artifacts that were hidden in storage for decades. For this enormous project, an expertise team of the CIBM cooperated along with specialized expertise of scientific and academic institutes to identify and examine the authenticity of objects according to the new mankind's requirements.

Subsequently, this case study will try to present a report about the process of the project by focusing on the concept of museum development during the pandemic of covid-19. The main focus will be on the approaches that were used in this transformation and to redefine the way that modern services in museums are provided and to focus on development during the Covid pandemic.

## بازطراحی و باز آفرینی مفهوم توسعه موزهای: تغییر و تبدیل گنجینه و موزهها در موسسه فرهنگی موزههای بنیاد در عصر کرونا


### چکیده

باتوجه به شیوع همه گیری کووید-19 و تعطیلی مراکز فرهنگی و موسسات موزهای در جهان و به تبع آن در ایران فرصت و چالشی جدید را در مفاهیم توسعه ای پیش روی موزهها قرار داده است. از سویی دیگر نبود مخاطبین و بازدیدکنندگان در نمایشگاهها و موزهها، فرصت بسیار مناسبی در اختیار تیم متخصصان موزهای موسسه فرهنگی موزههای بنیاد قرار داد تا این چالش را در مفهوم توسعه موزهای و نمایشگاهی، ارتقاء محیط کاری، اصلاح محیط های پیشین موزهای، همکاری و تبادل با موسسات علمی و دانشگاهی به انجام رسانده و در نهایت به افزایش نیروی انسانی متخصص، در جهت ارائه بهتر خدمات فرهنگی و موزهای بانجامید. درهمین راستا یکی از مهمترین دستاوردهایی که میتوان به آن اشاره نمود بازطراحی و تبدیل بنای دفینه واقع در تهران به چهار موزهی هنر جهان، هنر اسلامی، گوهر و آرایههای تاریخی و یول بوده است. بنای دفینه که پیش از توسعه و در قبل از همه گیری کووید-19 ساختمان موزه پول و محل خزانههای آثار تاریخی بوده، در طی شیوع پاندمی، بازطراحی و بازآفرینی و درنهایت ارتقاء پیدا نمود. در دوره توسعهای جدید حدود ۴ هزار اثر به نمایش درآمده است که این امر موضوعی بسیار چالش برانگیز و منحصر به فرد در نوع خود محسوب می شود. به این منظور بخش قابل توجهی از آثار تاریخی که فرصت نمایش و ارائه برای آنها متصور نبوده و سالها در مخازن نگهداری میشدند، توسط تیمی از کارشناسان موسسه به همراه کارگروههای تخصصی از دیگر موسسات علمی و دانشگاهی، کارشناسی، اصالتسنجی و در فضایی باتوجه به نیازهای دنیای جدید بازتعریف و در اختیار مردم قرار گرفت. بر این اساس در این مقاله سعی خواهد شد تا با محور قرار دادن مفهوم توسعه موزهای با محوریت تغییر و تحولات صورت گرفته در عصر پاندمی گزارشی از فرآیند کارهای صورت گرفته ارائه شود. در این میان تمرکز اصلی در قبال رویکردهای بکار گرفته شده در این تحول، بازتعریف شیوه ارائه خدمات موزهای نوین و توجه به نگاهی جدید به مفهوم توسعه در عصر کرونا خواهد بود که بدان اشاره خواهد
